A unique exhibition that takes the simple geometrical form of the **polygon** as its starting point to investigate the infinite representations of shape and geometry in art, design and even science alike.

A **polygon** is defined as 'a closed plane figure bounded by three or more line segments' which leaves a rich choice of shapes and pattern to imaginative interpretation.

Here eighteen emerging artists and graphic designers have each been given a different geometric figure to explore. Their inspiration is taken from the shape and will be expressed by each individual artist in their own medium.

Polygon presents a multi-faceted portrait of the young contemporary art scene and reflects the way young artists are increasingly exploring collaborations and other event-based activity.

A group show by recent graduates and final year students from **Central Saint Martins, London College of Communication, University of Brighton, Denmark Design School** and **The Royal College of Art** will be an interesting insight into tomorrows art and design.
